After much consideration, and with great regret, we have concluded that we must postpone EAHN2020 (the EAHN Biennial conference), which was to have happened at the University of Edinburgh on 10-13 June. This was a difficult decision, but in view of the rapidly evolving impact of Covid-19, it has become essential. We are very sorry for any inconvenience caused. Registration for EAHN2020 has now been closed, and all deadlines for the submission of papers are now cancelled.

We do however intend to restage the conference in the same venue, and with as far as possible the same programme on 2-5 June 2021. The next few weeks will see us transition to the revised conference, to which we very much hope you will be able to contribute. We will circulate detailed information about the revised conference over the next few weeks.
